## Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT General Housekeeping Amendments



**TAKE NOTICE** that the Planning Advisory Committee of the Town of Smiths Falls will hold a public meeting on the **17th day of October 2024 beginning at 5:00 p.m**. in the Council Chambers at Town Hall to consider proposed amendments to the Town's Zoning By-law 10375-2022 pursuant to Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, as described below. Virtual participation in this meeting will be accommodated by request to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Planning Advisory Committee.

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** To make some housekeeping or technical changes, including clarification of general provisions. The proposed housekeeping amendment is intended to address administrative, interpretation and technical issues that have been identified through the day-to-day use of the By-law. The following identifies the changes that are proposed through this amendment:

- Section 2.11 (Enforcement Provisions) to update legislative references and improve administration
- Section 4.16 (Keeping of Animals) to harmonize the regulation of livestock (other than household pets) with the Animal Control By-law
- Section 4.24 (Objects Stored in Yards) to update provisions for storage of recreational vehicles
- Section 4.26 (Number of Dwellings on a Lot) to clarify where more than one dwelling can be built on a lot
- Section 4.28.6 (Barrier Free Parking Spaces) to harmonize requirements to Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act
- Section 4.28.8 (Driveway Width for Townhouses) to allow 3 m wide driveways at street townhouse lots
- Section 4.32 (Watercourse Setbacks) clarifies that vertical additions to structures within the required 30 m waterbody setback are permitted, so long as the footprint is not enlarged
- Remove and integrate definition of "Automobile Care" within "Automobile Service Station"
- Section 7.2.1 (R2 Zone Zone Provisions) to allow 0 m interior side yard setback for semi-detached dwellings that are divided into separate lots.

There is no key map attached to this notice given that the proposed housekeeping amendment applies to the whole of the Town of Smiths Falls.
